## One of Australia's premier private golf courses

Our two courses are recognised world wide and the name of Dr Alister MacKenzie and Royal Melbourne are synonymous. In 1926 Dr MacKenzie created the West Course and soon after he assisted Mr Alex Russell in designing the East Course which was ready for play in 1932.

The Canada Cup saw the creation of the "Composite Course" made up of holes from both the East and West courses. The Composite Course is now ranked in the top ten golf courses in the world by Golf Magazine with its other MacKenzie designed courses of Augusta and Cypress Point.

The Royal Melbourne Golf Club has hosted many national & international tournaments including numerous Australian Open's, the 1998 Presidents Cup and the Presidents Cup in November 2011.

# EVENT MANAGEMENT

- Initial meeting to discuss & establish your requirements for the day
- Collation of all information in the form of a function advice sheet
- Determining the style of play according to size of the field
- Arrange the draw for the field
- Arrange all competition pins such as nearest the pin etc..
- Arranging placement & collection of all sponsor signage on course & in clubhouse
- Arrange registration of all players on the day
- Arrange distribution of scorecards & other information to players at registration
- Starting of the field on the day with players briefing
- Assisting with selection of menu & wines
- Arrange any hire equipment required by players
- Arrange any audio visual requirements
- Collection & collation of all score cards & print out of the competition results
- Assist with table plan for guests
- Follow up to ensure all the arrangements were to the clients standard

# RMGC BOOKING CONDITIONS & TERMS

The following Terms and Conditions are designed to ensure that your corporate golf day runs smoothly from its inception. Should you have any queries regarding any point, please do not hesitate to contact our corporate golf day coordinator.

## BOOKING A CORPORATE GOLF DAY

Corporate Days are held every MONDAY at The Royal Melbourne Golf Club.  
A minimum number of 60 players are required to book a corporate golf day.  
A shotgun start is available from 7.30am (time of your choosing until 1pm)  
Send your deposit of 25% (or \$5,000) to confirm your golf day.  
Complete & return your booking application form with your deposit

## CANCELLATION (BY CLIENT) OF A CORPORATE GOLF DAY

A cancellation 12 weeks prior to your event will result in a charge of 50% per player according to the numbers advised in the initial application letter for lost business.  
A cancellation 16 weeks prior to your event will result in forfeiture of your deposit

## CANCELLATION (BY RMGC) OF A CORPORATE GOLF DAY

The Royal Melbourne Golf Club Inc. reserves the right to cancel a confirmed booking up 8 weeks prior to an event and the FULL deposit paid will be refunded.

## CONFIRMATION

Copy of Players List required by 10am on the Friday prior to your event  
Confirmation of final numbers will be required on the Thursday prior to your event  
Charges are applicable for numbers confirmed at this time.  
All Final details will be required 2 weeks prior to your event  
A minimum of 80 will be charged for your booking.

## SIGNAGE

All Signage (maximum 6) is required on the Friday prior to your event

## FACILITIES

The Royal Melbourne Golf Club Inc. is a fully licensed facility No food or beverages are permitted to be brought onto the premises  
Mobile telephones and smoking are not permitted within the Clubhouse.  
All golfers must wear soft spikes (These can be fitted by the Proshop on the day if required)  
Full access to clubhouse facilities, including locker rooms, member's bar and dining room  
Towels and showering facilities are available

## DRESS REQUIREMENTS

### COURSE

**Men:** Golf attire is expected to consist of a polo shirt with collar, tailored slacks or knee length tailored shorts. Traditional golf shoes are to be worn. Soft spikes only.

**Ladies:** Traditional golf attire is requested. Tailored slacks, skirts and long shorts are acceptable. Polo shirts with a collar are to be worn at all times

### CLUBHOUSE

**Men & Ladies:** Golf attire is expected in the bar & accepted on application in the dining room

### HOLE IN ONE POLICY

The Royal Melbourne Golf Club Inc. will authorize the holding of a Hole in One Competition providing the Rules of Amateur Status are not breached. To ensure compliance to the Rules of Amateur Status (as endorsed by the Australian Golf Union), the Club must be advised in writing that if an amateur golfer wins the prize (value greater than \$1,200), then the prize will be donated to a Charity of your choice.

### WET WEATHER POLICY

Should the golf course be deemed unplayable on the day of your event your deposit may be held over for a future event to be held within 12 months of your original booking
