COURSE AND CLUBHOUSE REGULATIONS

All Members, visitors and guests are required to maintain a standard of dress in keeping with the character and standing of the Club. We kindly ask that you familiarise yourself with the following dress regulations for the golf course and Clubhouse.

Golf Course

Men

Tailored trousers, plus fours and tailored shorts. Shirts should be collared, of neat appearance and tucked in. Golf shoes with soft spikes (no metal spikes) with short socks that are either predominantly white or complement the colour of other clothing permitted.

Not permitted: Denim jeans, track suits, football or rugby jumpers, golf hoodies, sweatshirts, trousers tucked into socks, cargo trousers/shorts, draw string trousers/shorts, clothing bearing writing or advertising material other than small badges or logos. Shoes not designed as golf shoes. It is preferred that all visible tattoos be covered at all times on the course and in the Clubhouse.

Women

Neat slacks, tailored golf shorts and skirts. Shirts should be collared, of neat appearance and tucked in. Golf shoes with soft spikes (no metal spikes) with short socks that are either predominantly white or complement the colour of other clothing permitted. Leggings and compression clothing may only be worn on-course under made-for-golf-attire.

Not permitted: Denim, track suits, cargo pants or shorts, draw string pants or shorts, golf hoodies, rugby jumpers, shirts and jumpers bearing writing or advertising material other than small badges or logos. No bare midriffs. Shoes not designed as golf shoes. It is preferred that all visible tattoos be covered at all times on the course and in the Clubhouse.

Walking Policy

Golf is a game best played walking. Golden age golf courses, such as Royal Melbourne, are designed to be walked. Tees are close to greens and walking the golf courses benefits its natural and sensitive environment. If you require a golf cart for medical reasons, we kindly ask that a doctor's certificate is provided in advance of your visit.

Smoking Policy

The Royal Melbourne Golf Club is a smoke free environment. The use of tobacco and smoking products including E-cigarettes are not permitted on the courses, carpark, Clubhouse surrounds and practice areas.

Clubhouse

Men and Women

Golf attire is acceptable in the Clubhouse however, in extreme weather conditions it is expected that golfers change wet or soiled clothing. Golf shoes may be worn in the bar area providing that they are clean but changed for other areas. Jacket and tie may be required at formal events. Caps and visors must be removed when entering the Clubhouse and mobile phones must be switched to silent. Phone calls may only be made in the locker rooms, but can be made anywhere in the case of a medical emergency.
